MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

DRIVE TO THE MASAI MARA - AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

After breakfast and a briefing, we depart Nairobi at approximately 8am and drive to the Masai Mara National Reserve (approximately 5 hours). We will check in and have lunch at Ilkeliani Camp before embarking on our first game drive in Kenya's most famous wildlife conservation area.



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Ilkeliani Camp is a charming sanctuary nestled in the heart of the renowned Maasai Mara, this haven is beautifully positioned within a serene clearing along the Talek River in the Maasai Mara National Reserve and highly favoured by elephants, drawn to its banks to drink. Where Ilkeliani is not available, we stay at Mara Maisha Camp. Mara Maisha Camp is a luxury tented camp located just 4.5km from Talek Gate of the Maasai Mara and renowned for its fantastic service, food and spacious well-appointed permanent tented rooms.

TUESDAY

MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

FULL DAY UNLIMITED GAME VIEWING

Today we spend a full day game viewing in the Masai Mara Reserve.

Masai Mara National Reserve



World-renowned the Masai Mara Reserve covers an area of about 1,510 square kilometres and is named after the Maasai people who inhabit the area and the Mara River that runs through it.

The Maasai Mara is famous for its rich wildlife and across its vast plains of the Mara, visitors are able to witness lions, cheetahs, leopards, elephants, and an infinite variety of other species in their natural habitats.

Together with the Serengeti in Tanzania, it forms a unique, connected ecosystem and each July to October more than 1.5 million wildebeest, zebra and antelopes that migrate from the Serengeti to the Mara in search of food and water.

DAY 4

WEDNESDAY

LAKE NAKURU

AFTERNOON GAME DRIVE

After breakfast we will drive to Lake Nakuru National Park (approx. 4 hours drive). On arrival we will check in at our accommodation and enjoy lunch before entering the park for an afternoon of game viewing.

Lake Nakuru National Park



Lake Nakuru is a shallow, alkaline lake located in the Rift Valley region of Kenya. Covering an area of approximately 62 square kilometres, the lake is situated in Lake Nakuru National Park and is a popular tourist destination due to its abundant wildlife and stunning natural beauty.

The Lake is often associated with flamingos which if the environmental conditions are right, be seen en masse wading in the shallow waters along the lake's edges. In addition to flamingos, the lake is also home to a variety of other bird species, including pelicans, cormorants, and African fish eagles.

Apart from its birdlife, Lake Nakuru National Park is also home to a diverse range of wildlife as well as both black and white rhinoceroses, which have been successfully reintroduced into the area and are now protected by the park's rangers.

Today we spend a full day game viewing in Amboseli National Park.

Amboseli National Park



At just over 390 square kilometres Amboseli National Park boasts breath taking views of Africa's highest peak Kilimanjaro, located just over the border in Tanzania. The park is renowned for its iconic large herds of

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large-tusked elephants gracefully roaming the savannahs dotted with acacia trees. The name "Amboseli" comes from a Maasai word meaning "salty dust" as well as savannah there are four other habitats to explore including the dried-up bed of Lake Amboseli, wetlands with sulphur springs and woodlands. In addition to elephant the park is an excellent place to view a wide range of species.

After breakfast at our camp we will leave around 8am to transfer to the Tarakea Border Post (approx. 2 hour drive). Here you will farewell your Kenyan guide and after completing the immigration/customs formalities you will be welcomed by your Tanzanian Guide from ATB Safaris Tanzania. We will drive to Arusha visiting enroute with a local guide the Kinukamori Waterfalls, one of three main waterfalls in the Marangu area. Enjoy a picnic lunch before continuing to Arusha (approx. 5 hour drive).

LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

GAME VIEWING

Breakfast and briefing at the lodge. Departing at 8am, drive to Lake Manyara NP. Morning and afternoon, unlimited game viewing. Picnic lunch. Later we drive to the Karatu area for dinner and overnight at Country Lodge.

Lake Manyara National Park



Set below the Rift Valley Escarpment Lake Manyara National Park encompasses a number of different habitats. The name “Manyara” comes from the Maasai word *emanyara*, which is a euphorbia species of plant that is grown into a hedge around a family homestead.

The park is best known for its tree-climbing lions, blue monkeys, huge troops of baboons and elephant herds as well as its dramatic views of the Rift Valley. The shallow alkaline lake can attract thousands of greater and lesser flamingos and the National Park itself is a hotspot for birders as over 300 species of resident and migratory birds have been recorded here.

MONDAY

NGORONGORO CRATER - SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

GAME VIEWING

Breakfast at the lodge. Drive to Ngorongoro Crater (20 minutes from the lodge to the gate entrance) for a half day crater safari (5 hours). Continue to Serengeti NP. Picnic lunch enroute. Dinner and overnight at Hippo Trails Camp

Ngorongoro Crater



A world heritage site, the Ngorongoro Crater world's largest intact volcanic caldera and is often considered to be the 8th wonder of the world. The 2,000 feet high walls of the approximately 16km wide crater create natural amphitheatre and most of the animals are resident and remain year-round.

There are approximately 20,000 large mammals at any given time within the Crater walls. Species found in the Crater include Rhino, Lion, Hyena, Elephant, Warthog, Cheetah, Jackal, Eland, Serval Cat, Hippo and Flamingo.

DAY 10

TUESDAY

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

FULL UNLIMITED DAY OF GAME VIEWING

Depending on the time of the year and the rains it will determine where you will travel to for full day game viewing drive, to follow the Wildebeests and Zebras on their migration route.

Dec to Mar: game drive in Southern Serengeti NP (Day 3) en route for overnight in Central Serengeti NP

Apr to May: full day game drive in Central Serengeti NP

Jun: full day game drive to Western Serengeti NP

Jul to Oct: full day game drive to Northern Serengeti NP

Nov: full day game drive in Central Serengeti NP

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Serengeti National Park



Undoubtedly Africa's most famous national park, the name "Serengeti" is derived from the word used by the Maasai to describe the area, *siringet*, which means "the place where the land runs on forever. The park is massive and covers 14,750 square kilometres (5,700 sq mi) and with a variety of habitats including grassland plains, savanna, riverine forest, and woodlands. The park lies in north-western Tanzania, bordered to the north Kenya, where it is continues as the Maasai Mara National Reserve.

Stunningly beautiful, the Serengeti offers amazing year-round game viewing boasting the highest density of large predators, including lions, leopards and cheetahs in the world. It is also home to the Great Migration where over 2 million wildebeest follow their instincts and the smell of rain on a never-ending circular route to seek out the best grasses to graze on.

DAY 11

WEDNESDAY

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK - KARATU

GAME VIEWING & COFFEE TOUR

Early morning game viewing. Breakfast at the camp. Drive to Karatu with more game viewing and picnic en route. Later enjoy a 1.5 hour guided tour of a local coffee plantation. Dinner and overnight at Marera Safari Lodge.



Karatu

Karatu, is strategically located about halfway between the Ngorongoro Crater and Tarangire National Park and breaks up an otherwise long drive. It's not uncommon to see Massai herding goats and cattle along the roadside and the shops sell an eclectic mix of wares.

Outside of town the countryside is dotted with farms, coffee plantations and thick forests. Lodges in this area have beautiful gardens. You may even spot a brilliantly coloured sunbird flitting from flower to flower feeding on nectar.

TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

GAME VIEWING

Breakfast at the lodge. Drive to Tarangire NP (approximately 2 hours). Morning and afternoon unlimited game viewing. Picnic lunch. Dinner and overnight at Sangaiwe Tented Lodge.

Tarangire National Park



Tarangire is a real gem. Known for some of the best elephant viewing in Tanzania, the park also hosts a 'mini migration' at the height of the dry season as large numbers of zebra and other animals make their way into the park to quench their thirst at Tarangire River.

The park is incredibly scenic and home to some enormous Baobab trees. In terms of wildlife, in addition to elephant other herbivores that are resident year-round include mongoose, giraffe, bushbuck, rock hyrax,

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hartebeest, dik-dik, impala, waterbuck, warthog and reedbuck. Lions are abundant in Tarangire and are regularly encountered and leopard are often spotted. For birders the park is especially good for spotting raptors with bateleur eagle, tawny eagle, long-crested eagle, martial eagle, fish eagle and spotted eagle owl all regularly sighted.
